- Educators will need to apply online to the program. Accepted participants will have two weeks to pay a one-time registration fee of \$25
 - Other expenses such as hotel room, meals, transportation via charter, and materials are provided for by NCFA and sponsors
- Participants will stay in single occupancy rooms
- Workshop is geared towards formal and non-formal STEM professionals with emphasis on 3rd-12th grade science educators
 - High school teachers that lead topics aligned to earth, environmental, biology, and agriculture will find our program most beneficial
 - Registration for the program is first-come-first-serve basis
- Max capacity for each workshop is 25 participants
